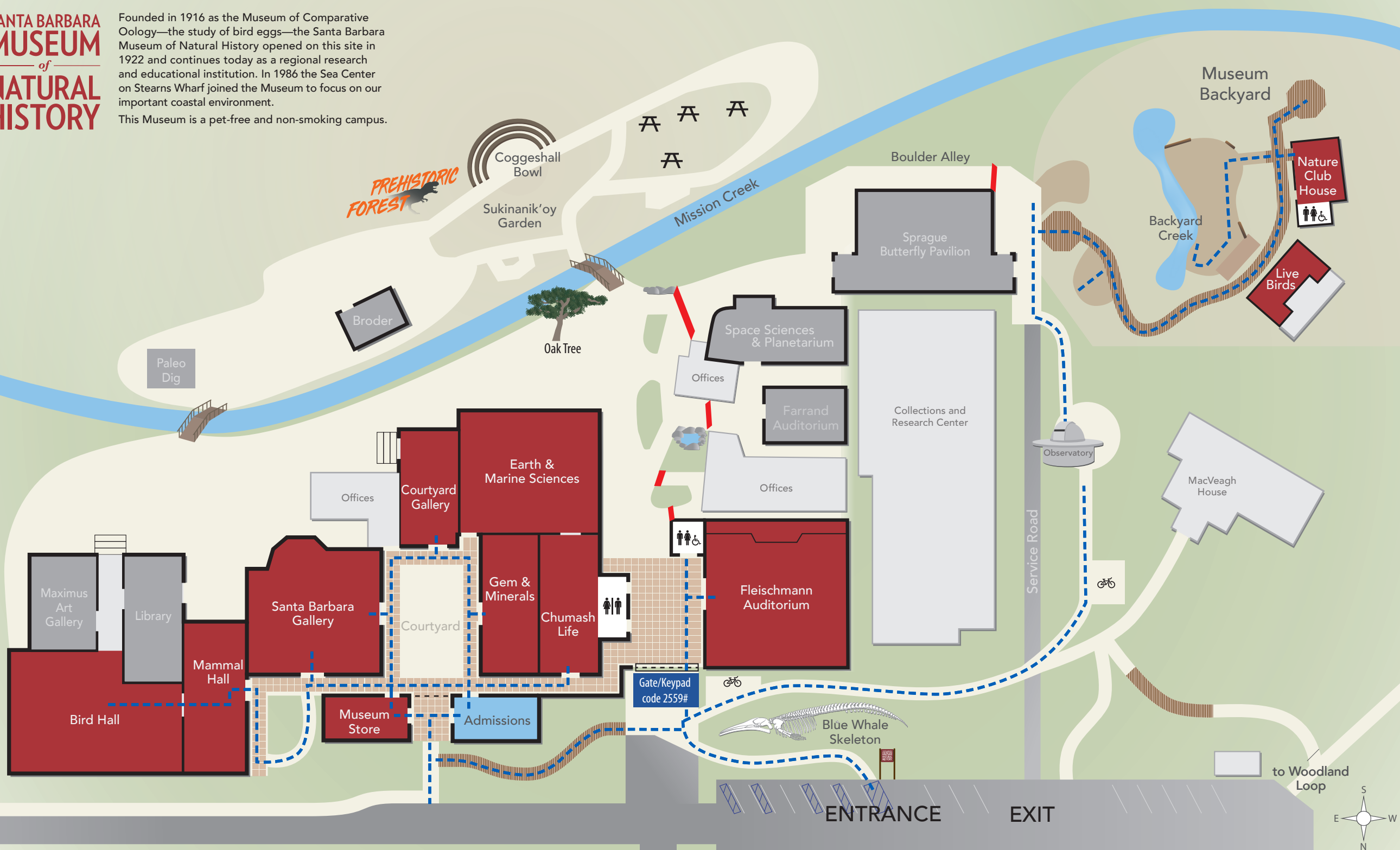


SANTA BARBARA MUSEUM
