This event has been one of the Museum's most successful fundraisers, with proceeds benefiting our Exhibit and Education Programs. Our 2010 had more than 3,000 shoppers, 30 vendors, and over 75 dancers and musicians. We look forward to another fantastic event!

**Please carefully read and fill out the application.** Please note that submittal of an application does not guarantee a performance spot. You will be contacted once your application and performance time preference are reviewed. Accepted performers will be notified by October 3, 2011.

Below are procedures and guidelines that apply to our 2011 event.

- **PERFORMANCE DATES:**

Dance and music performances will occur on Saturday, December 3 and Sunday, December 4.

- **PERFORMANCES:**

All performers are volunteers. We have a wide spectrum of excellent performers ranging from professionals, student cultural groups, to student and children's classes.

- **VENUE:**

The Tribal Arts Performance Pavilion is located outside under a large tent. Dancers will be dancing on ground level (asphalt), on a Persian-style rug that is approximately 10'x 12'. Shoes are recommended. All performances are announced by an MC.

- **ARRIVAL:**

Please arrive 30 minutes before your performance time. Please check in at the Museum's Admissions office where you will be greeted and directed to the Green Room.

- **PARKING:**

Parking is free. Please note that our parking lot will be very full during the festival. Please give yourself sufficient time to find a parking spot and arrive 30 minutes before your performance time. Carpooling is encouraged.

- **MUSIC:**

If you are performing to music on a CD, please bring two copies of your music that have been tested. The CD must be labeled with your NAME, DATE, AND TIME OF YOUR PERFORMANCE. Please hand Patricia or her assistant your CD once you arrive and it will be placed in the queue.

- **GREEN ROOM:**

The Museum will provide performers a Green Room with light refreshments and snacks. Performers can also use it to store their belongings. Please note that it will not be locked and it will be accessible to all performers. There will also be a costume changing screen for those who wish to have privacy. Please note that the Green Room is open to both men and women.

- **WEATHER/RAIN PLAN:**

Since our music and performances are located outside, we will have to assess the weather the day before or the day of the performances. The Museum will be in contact with performers via e-mail and/or telephone if performances are cancelled due to rain.

- **USE OF FLAMES OR INCENSE:**

Please note that no flames or incense can be used in the Tribal Arts Performance Pavilion.

- **PHOTO RELEASE FORM:**

Please review the photo release form with your dancers and students (if applicable), sign on behalf of your group, and return to the Museum.
