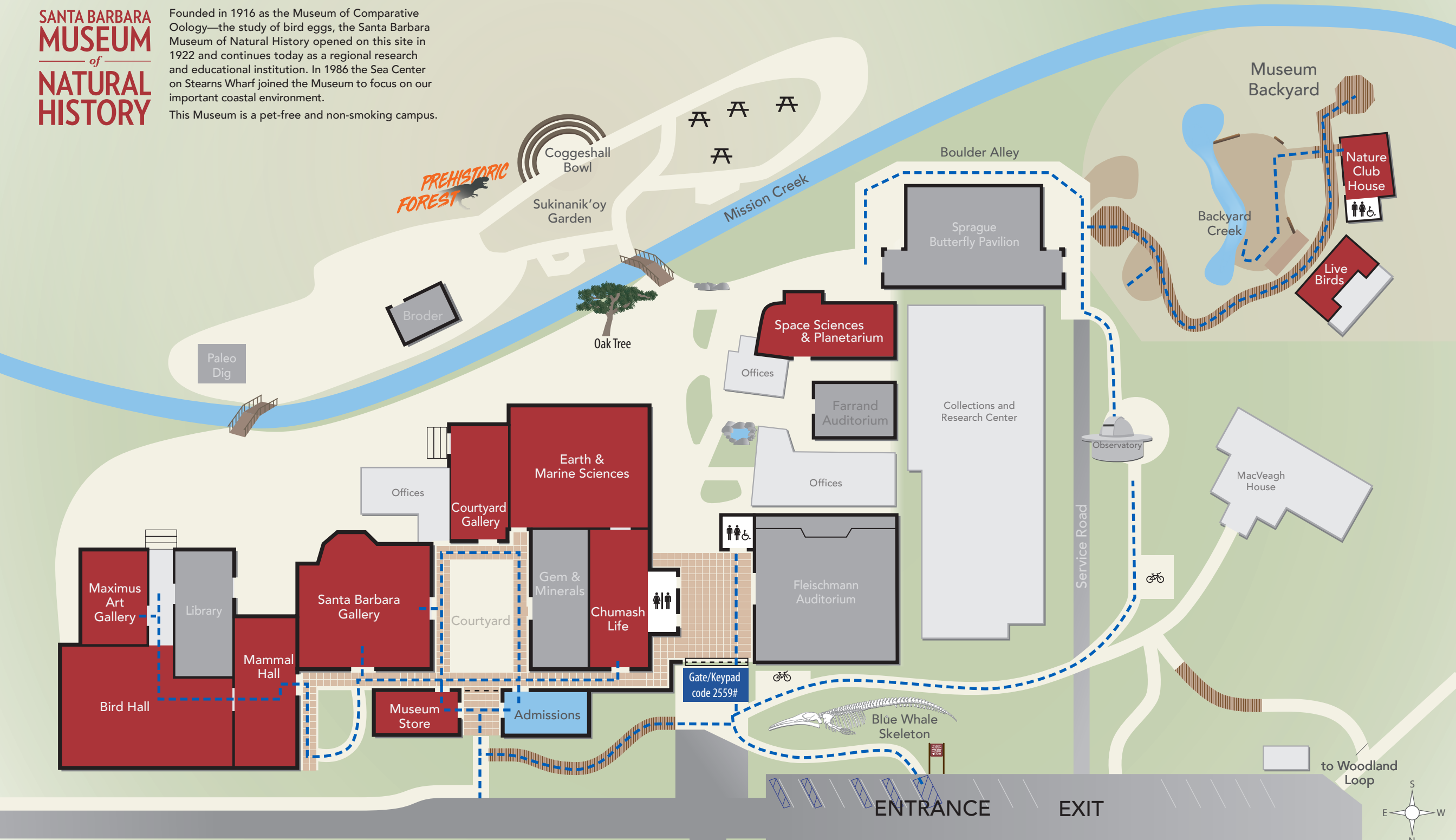


**SANTA BARBARA MUSEUM**
